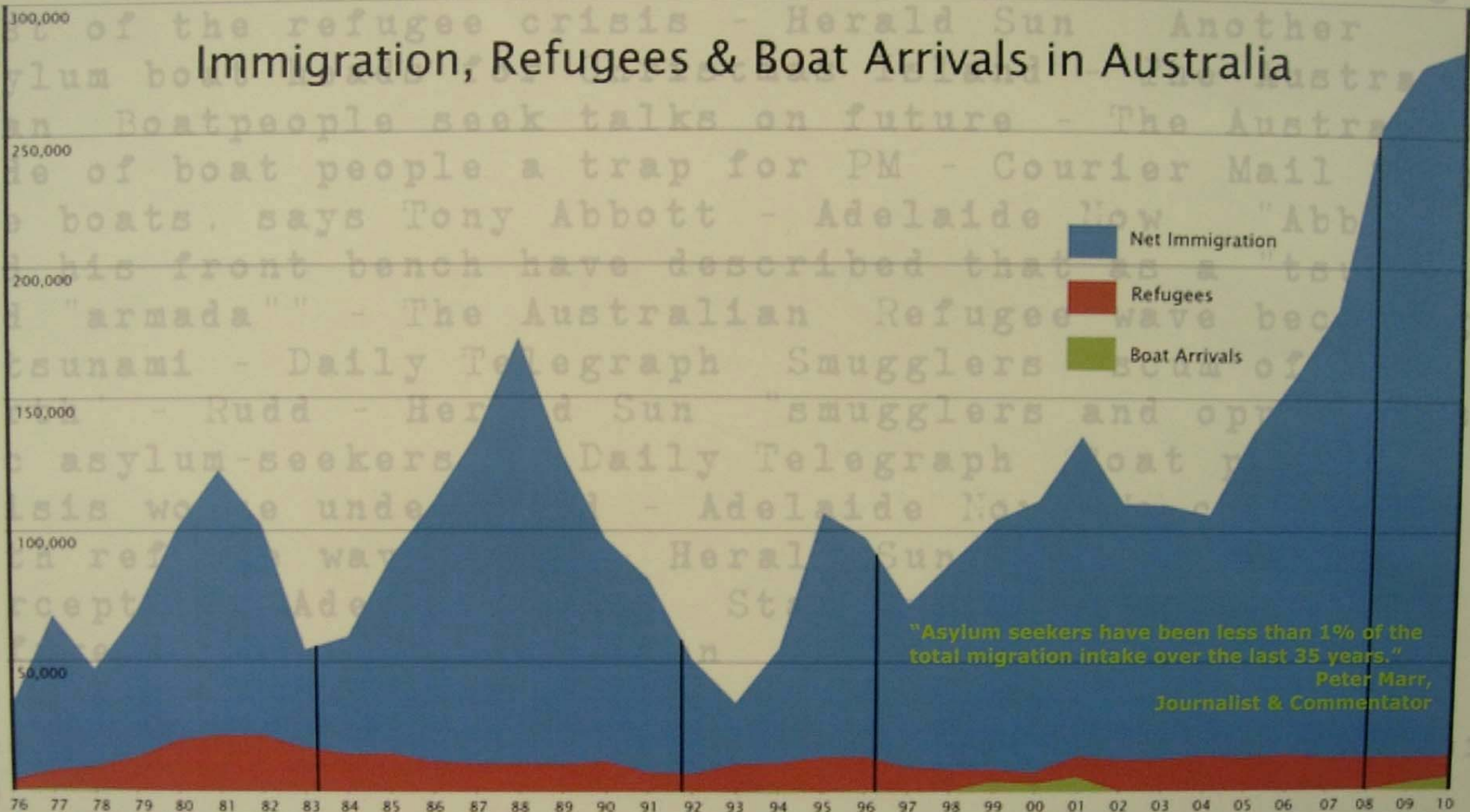

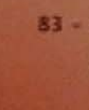

POLITICS



MALCOLM FRASER
LIBERAL: 1975 - 1983

- 76 - First boat arrives in Australia
- 77-78 - Approaches regional governments to keep refugees in camps
- 82 - Introduces individual determination



BOB HAWKE
LABOR: 1983 - 1991

- 83 - Endorses the durable solutions policy proposed by the UNHCR. This includes:
 - Voluntary repatriation
 - Social integration into country of first asylum
 - Last resort of resettlement into Australia



PAUL KEATING
1991-1996

- 92 - Introduces mandatory detention policy
- 94 - Removes detention time limit



JOHN HOWARD
LIBERAL: 1996 - 2007

- 96 - Continues policy of mandatory detention
 - 99 - Brings in temporary protection visas
 - 01 - The 'Pacific Solution'
- This includes:

- Excising of islands from Australia's migration zone
- Interdiction of boats by the Australian Navy
